BTEC Level 3 Close Protection Operation

(150 Hour/SIA compliant)

The BTEC Level 3 Certificate in Close Protection Operations has been developed to meet the training and licensing requirements of the Security Industry Authority (SIA). This programme is delivered in a live environment at our Belfast Approved Centre by former Police and Military Close Protection Instructors, who are also operational in the UK, Ireland and the Middle East. Who Should Attend/Entry Requirements

Persons engaged in close protection duties and those wishing to achieve a nationally recognised qualification. Students must hold a valid 4 Day HSE First Aid Certificate, a Criminal Records Check is required prior to entry onto this course.

Course Content

- Unit 1 Skills and Team Work in Close Protection
- Unit 2 Law and Legislation, Communication, Conflict Management Skills
- Unit 3 Risk Assessment, Operational Planning and Safe Route Selection
- Unit 4 Surveillance, Reconnaissance, Incidents and Dilemmas
- Unit 5 Techniques for Close Protection Operatives

Assessment

Assessment is made throughout the course by participation in tasks, exercises, and a compulsory 1 hour 30 minute multiple choice examination.

Certification

Successful candidates will be awarded the Edexcel Level 3 Certificate in Close Protection Operations, together with the [Skills for Security/Syl Security Supervisor Certificate](#).
