## Practical Security Surveying and Auditing

(Course Ref: PSS&A)

### Course Overview:

An extensive study of the twin processes of security surveying and auditing as they relate to both public and private sector corporations.

The course is carried out over a two-day period to enable delegates to combine the theoretical study of this important topic with a detailed and practical scenario exercise.

### Learning Outcomes:

On completion of this course, delegates will be trained to:

- Carry out security risk assessments and audits
- Identify the general and specific threats and risks to their organisation
- Understand the human and technological solutions that can be applied
- Be able to produce a written and structured survey report

### Who Should Attend:

This course is suitable for Security Managers and Directors, Site Security Managers, Facilities Managers and all other managers with the responsibility for on site security.

This course is also suitable for Security Supervisors who aspire to a management role.

### Course Contents Includes:

- The nature of threats to public and private sector corporations
- Understanding the security survey and audit processes
- The principles of corporate governance and social responsibility
- The 'Eight Principles of Security' and their relevance to security surveying and auditing process
- The principles of security risk management
- The principles of crime prevention through environmental design
- The principle of ASRA (Area Security Risk Analysis)
- An examination of both human and technical security solutions
- A study of counter-surveillance measures and incident recording
- A practical security survey/audit exercise and instruction and guidance for the report writing process
- Concluding group discussion and Q & A session
